The year 2025 was a busy, challenging, yet impactful one for CHINADA. At home, CHINADA acted as the Testing Authority for the 15th National Games, the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities & the 9th National Special Olympic Games, and the 1st Youth Athletics Games of the People's Republic of China, managing anti-doping programs for these major national events. Besides, we provided doping control at more than 130 international events including the 9th Asian Winter Games Harbin 2025 and the 12th World Games in Chengdu as the Sample Collection Authority, while maintaining high quality in our routine work.

Looking ahead, 2026 will bring new opportunities and challenges. CHINADA will dedicate efforts to anti-doping operations for events including the Youth Athletics Games and the National Youth Games for Football, Basketball and Volleyball, while providing support for the 6th Asian Beach Games in Sanya and the 33th Winter Universiade in Changchun. Besides, we will conduct pre-games testing for Chinese delegations at international events such as the Milano Cortina Winter Olympic Games, Aichi-Nagoya Asian Games, and Dakar Summer Youth Olympic Games. To meet these demands, CHINADA will further strengthen intelligence-led testing, broaden and diversify education efforts, and enhance compliance oversight.

We remain committed to openness and collaboration with our partners at home and abroad. With shared determination, we will continue working to safeguard the rights of clean athletes and to contribute to a stronger and more trustful global anti-doping system.

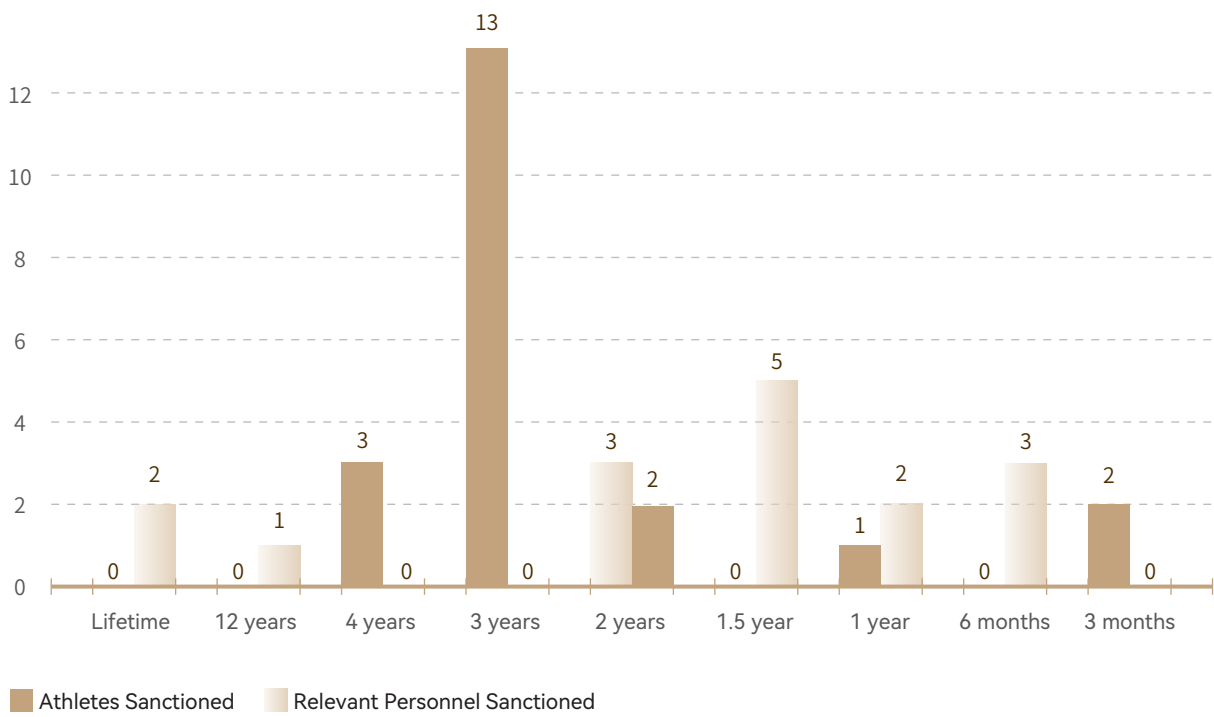

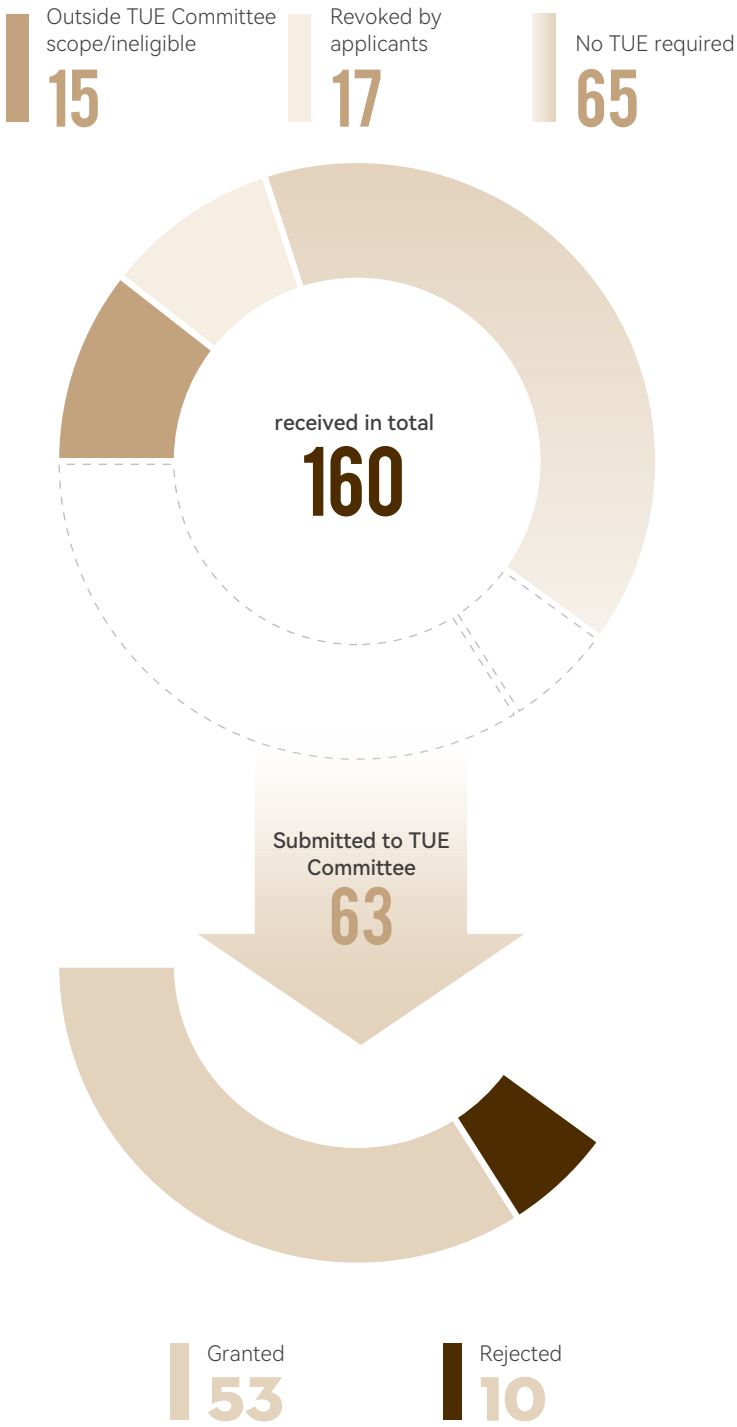

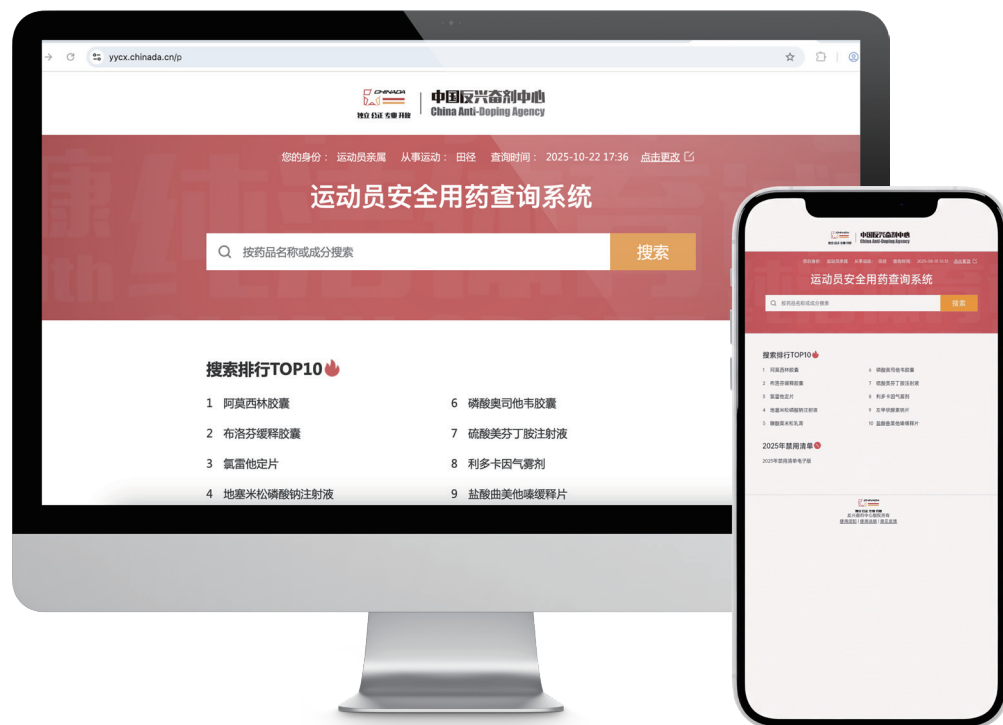
